Train & Tracks

Free train rides! All aboard for a 20-minute ride on our comfy passenger coaches with friendly on-board staff. To reduce time in line, we will hand out tickets to folks as they get into the Ride Ticket Line. Each train has a different colored ticket.

Once you get a ticket, you can check out other activities until it's time to board the train indicated on your ticket.

Only enter the **Boarding Line** when your train is next to board. Watch for signs indicating which train will be boarding next.

Climb Aboard! Take a peek inside the cab of a powerful locomotive. Ask questions to our knowledgeable and helpful staff.

Track Maintainers! Check out specialized track maintenance heavy equipment and talk to railroad maintenance experts to discover how we keep our rail corridor ready for train traffic.

Fabulous Freight! The Alaska Railroad hauls nearly 4 million tons of freight every year. Check out a variety of freight cars that make this efficient and green mode of transportation possible - from fuel tanker cars, to gravel/coal hoppers, to trailer-on-flat cars and more.

FREE TRAIN RIDES BOARDING SCHEDULE

Eight (8) trains are planned to operate between 10:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m. This schedule assumes trains operate approximately every 30-minutes to include 5-minute boarding, a 20-minute ride, and 5-minute deboarding. The schedule is meant as a guide only.

Boarding time changes will be noted and updated throughout the day. On your ticket, please note the Train Number (#) and approximate boarding time.

Enter the **Boarding Line** at least 5 minutes prior the boarding time noted and updated here. Please do not enter the Boarding Line if the Train # on your ticket does not match the Train # on the **Now Boarding Train** # sign shown at the Boarding Line. Listen for boarding reminder announcements.
