Trains & Tracks

Free train rides! All aboard for a 20-minute ride in our comfy passenger coaches with friendly tour guides. To reduce time spent in line, we'll hand out tickets to folks as they get into the **Ticket Line**. Each of 9 train rides has a different colored ticket. Once you get a ticket, check out other activities until it's time to board the train # indicated on your ticket. Only enter the **Boarding Line** when your train is <u>next</u> to board. Watch for signs indicating the train number that will be boarding next.

Climb aboard! Experience the inside of an Alaska Railroad passenger train. Explore luxury passenger railcars and take a peek inside the cab of a powerful locomotive. While aboard, check in with local experts representing communities and activities along the railroad route.

Track Maintainers! Check out specialized track maintenance heavy equipment and talk to railroad maintenance experts to discover how we keep our rail corridor ready for train traffic.

Fabulous Freight! The Alaska Railroad hauls nearly 4 million tons of freight every year. Check out the variety of freight cars that make this efficient and green mode of transportation possible – from fuel tanker cars, to gravel/coal hoppers, to trailer-toting flat cars and more!
