"In this year of centennial celebration, railroaders are particularly proud to share what they do, how they do it, and the tools and equipment that they use every day to provide passenger and freight rail transportation," added Terry.

The event offers plenty of opportunities to engage with railroad employees from across the company. For example:

- engineers, conductors and tour guides welcome folks aboard the train for a ride
- transportation experts explain the SD7OMAC locomotive to those stepping up into the cab
- mechanics and heavy equipment operators offer first-hand insight into how massive track maintenance equipment works
- marketing & sales teams offer exclusive coupons valid for 2-for-1 rail travel deals
- reservations agents at the ticket window can help people plan their next railroad travel adventure
- Alaska Railroad Gift Shop sales technicians can help folks with open house deals on merchandise
- human resources reps can answer questions about job openings that lead to rewarding careers
- more railroader volunteers will give kids temporary tattoos, provide cool giveaways, and help folks enter the prize drawings (for rail travel, centennial posters, and/or golden spikes).
- Aboard the passenger train on display, we've invited representatives from rail belt communities and attractions to talk to folks who come onboard to explore the passenger train on static display.
