Questions & Answers

- Q: Are the cybersecurity team members DOA IT employees or ARRC employees?
 A: The cybersecurity team will be comprised of ARRC Employees, plus the CAP, CIP and PM Contractors.
- 4. Q: Will ARRC's cybersecurity team be able to implement ARRC policy over State of Alaska cybersecurity policy?
 A: ARRC is not a department of the State of Alaska. ARRC has its own cybersecurity policies in place.
- Q: How large is the network? i.e. how many users and locations of the network?
 A: Our network is large, complex and involves multiple transport modes. Most of our users do not interact with the network resources in question as they are to support OT.
- What tools or systems are you currently using for Cyber Security?
 A: ARRC will not be disclosing specific information regarding our current system during the solicitation, any information needed to complete the work will be shared after award of the contract and NDA and Security documents are executed.
- 7. Do you have documentation and internal policies? When was the last time those were reviewed?

A: Yes. ARRC internal policies are reviewed annually.
