Addendum Number 4

Invitation to Bid 25-43-213315 25-43 ITB MP66.09 MP67.51 Culvert Replacement ARRC

Offers will be received until 3:00 pm local time on June 12, 2025 (Extended to June 26, 2025).

This addendum is being issued to provide information as follows:

Question 1: Is there a specific Army Corps permit for this project or does it currently fall under a Nationwide permit?

Answer 1: This project currently falls under a Nationwide permit.

Question 2: The culvert at 66.09 is deteriorated to such a degree, it appears that it would not support train traffic. Has the railroad reinforced the section under the tracks? Answer 2: In years past, ARRC used to slip new smaller diameter culverts (usually CMPs) inside larger failing culverts, so it is a possibility; however, we have not confirmed any reinforcement sections inside or around the rotten culvert.

Question 3: Could a temporary diversion culvert be abandoned in place at the completion of the project?

Answer 3: Not likely, especially considering the proximity of a diversion culvert to the main culvert. ARRC will however review submitted VEP's on a case-by-case basis. The contractor is responsible for presenting their work plan, including temporary (in this case permanent) works and proposed in water work windows, for their fish habitat permit.

Questions 4: Can contractors lease a few side dumps and flatcars, for the culvert replacement at MP 66-67

Answer 4: ARRC will not lease any cars directly to a contractor, however, we can provide pricing for a special work train to deliver material to be coordinated through ARRC Marketing.
