### Bidder's Questions

1. Is the BICSI certification criteria change a requirement now based on a change in the project or its funding source(s)?  
**Yes. Based on further technical review of the specialized communications and structured cabling work required for this project, BICSI certification has been established as a minimum technical qualification to ensure consistent quality and system performance in a mobile rail environment.**
2. The supervisory requirement for BICSI certification now places this requirement on the Prime contractor since the prime contractor employees cannot be supervised by a subcontractor employee. Is there an option to modify this supervisory requirement?

**Yes.**

**Update to Section B: Statement of Services; Minimum Qualifications 3. Licensing & Insurance:**

- Contractor must possess all required state or municipal licenses for low-voltage installation work.
- Contractor must carry general liability insurance, workers' compensation, and automobile liability insurance, with minimum coverage amounts specified in the solicitation.
- ~~○ At least one on-site supervisor shall hold a BICSI Technician certification. Contractor shall provide copies of all BICSI certification credentials. All certifications must be current and in good standing. Owner reserves the right to verify credentials through BICSI's online verification system. If any certified personnel leave the project, Contractor shall replace them with equally qualified certified personnel.~~
- **\*\*\* The Contractor shall provide personnel qualified in information and communications technology (ICT) systems and structured cabling practices. At least one individual assigned to the project shall hold a current BICSI certification (RCDD, BICSI TECH, INST1/2, or equivalent). This requirement may be met by the Prime Contractor or a subcontractor performing the ICT-related scope. The BICSI-certified individual shall be responsible for technical oversight and quality assurance of the communications installation work on the railcars. Overall project management and contractual responsibility shall remain with the Prime Contractor. \*\*\***
