#### Addendum Number 3

### ITB 22-41-209504 Bridge 147.4 Pier Replacements

# This Addendum is being issued to provide information as follows:

#### **Question & Answers:**

 Q: Bid Schedule, Bid items M1, M2 and M3: For each of these items, do you want just the difference in price between the base item and the modified item, or the full value of the modified item? (For example – base price - \$100/lf, modified material price -\$110/lf, unit price shows as \$10/lf \*\* OR \*\* 960 If @ \$110/lf = \$105,600 extended)

A: Please provide full value, for example, under column "Unit Bid Price", please provide the unit price in units of "Linear Foot". Under column "Amount Bid", please provide the cumulative price for the estimated quantity provided.

2. Q: Bid Schedule, Bid items, M1, M2 and M3: As it is assumed that only one of these modified pile materials may be selected in lieu of the base bid material, should the extended price for all of these be totaled up in the Total Additive Alternate Bid cell? Seems like each of these would be priced as their own alternative, instead of lumping them all together.

A: Correct, the cell "Total Additive Alternate Bid" need not be filled in and will not be used for award purposes. The intent of these additive alternates is to allow the contractor to provide pricing on alternative methods, or extra work that may be contingent on bid pricing.

3. Q: For obtaining prices for the ARRC work train and/or train support, do you have a contact name and phone number for someone in ARRC Marketing? I did not see one listed.

A: Although import of additional material above that which ARRC has previously offered to transport and in addition to the material already on site, is discouraged. However, there is a possibility to utilize ARRC's maintenance cars to import some additional material.
