SECTION C SCOPE OF WORK

The Alaska Railroad Corporation (ARRC) is a full-service railroad providing passenger and freight services within Alaska. ARRC operates and maintains over 650 miles of track, serving communities from the ports of Seward and Whittier in Southcentral Alaska, north to Fairbanks in the Interior. Our rail connects with the lower 48 by rail barge, docking in Seattle, Washington.

ARRC is seeking bids for the disposal of approximately 45,000 railroad ties per year.

Ties are treated with creosote and will have steel hardware still attached.

Bidders are asked to provide a cost per tie where ARRC will be responsible for the delivery of the spent ties via gondola. We are also requesting a cost per tie with contractor-provided transportation from Anchorage, Alaska. In this case, ARRC would provide loading services.

Upon taking possession of the ties, it is the bidder's responsibility to ensure that all applicable laws, regulations, and other governmental requirements are followed in all respects, including but not limited to the use, transportation, disposal, combustion or recycling of treated railroad ties.

Disposal is to commence in calendar year 2023.

Bidder will need to provide an anticipated start date.
